Welcome to the Learnforeignlanguageskills.com oral preparation pack for the French Leaving certificate. In this pack, you will find over 200 questions which can be asked in the oral as well as a PDF document with all the questions written out and the translation. While we cannot predict the questions you will be asked on the day, these questions are a good sample of what could come up. Remember that the oral exam is the same for ordinary level and higher level students. It is worth 20% of the ordinary level exam and 25% of the higher level exam.

Students tend to concentrate on preparing answers but do not work on questions. This results in students struggling understanding the examiner or mixing up a question with another.

The best way to use the series of questions is to listen to the questions without the written list in front of you and try to figure out what the question means and what you would answer. Pay particular attention to the question word used, the tense and prepositions as you usually need the same tense in your answer. Questions in French can be asked different ways so the questions you will hear in these series are using the different ways but the key vocabulary and tense will stay the same. If you struggle with understanding a question, check with the written version and if need be the translation. At times, students know the written version of the question but do not know how it sounds.

On the day of the exam, the first question the examiner will ask you is: "Avez-vous apporté un document ?". The *document* is an option. If you have brought a *document*, give your *document* to the examiner. The discussion on the *document* tends to happen about half way through your oral more or less. If you do not have a document, just say "non, je n'ai pas de document".

The questions you will hear are grouped by topics. The topics are: *Moi-même, la famille, où j'habite, la routine, à l'école, le temps libre, les petits boulots, les vacances, la santé et autres.*

Last piece of advice before we start the questions, the examiner uses what you tell him or her to form his or her next questions.
